

Revenue Scotland Recruitment

Revenue Scotland is delighted to announce that a significant recruitment campaign for our Tax Specialist roles has gone live. As well as post-specific roles at B1 and C1 levels, we anticipate future vacancies across bands B2 and B3 over the next 9 months. We are recruiting for all roles and will maintain a reserve list of candidates and will fill posts as they arise over the next nine months. **We also welcome applications from people who would like to be considered for the roles on a secondment basis.**

We began operating on 1 April 2015 and, in the two years since then, have transferred over £1bn of tax collected to the Scottish Consolidated Fund, contributing to Scottish public services. As we move into our third operational year, it's a great time to join us!



We are recruiting for Tax Specialist roles across B1, B2, B3 and C1 grades. We will be recruiting for specific vacancies in our Tax Teams and will maintain a reserve list of candidates who pass the assessment process. This means that, as Tax Specialist vacancies become available in the next 9 months, we can offer roles to those on the reserve list.

Candidates from other government departments (OGD) can apply although we will fully consider applicants from the Scottish Government Common Citizenship group first. Once that is complete, we can consider applications from our OGD applicants.
