

Revenue Scotland Direct Debit: Report Consent



Where agents have signed up to Revenue Scotland's Direct Debit Scheme they will be issued with a report a few days prior to the collection of payment. This report details those returns with the amounts due to be collected on a specific date and includes for each tax return, the agent's name, agent's reference, payment reference, Revenue Scotland references and the amount.

Revenue Scotland takes the security of data seriously and although it does not contain protected taxpayer information, our preference is to email these reports to a secure email address. We require your consent to issue these reports whether that be to your secure or unsecure email account(s). Failure to consent may lead to access to the Direct Debit scheme being removed.
